## News April 2011

### Meeting on 31<sup>st</sup> March - Feed-in Tariffs and the Renewable Heat Incentive

At the March meeting Trevor Marshall gave a talk on renewable energy, mainly centred around solar panels, and explained how the Government Feed-in Tariffs and Renewable Heat Incentive cash back scheme works. This led to a lengthy discussion on the merits of solar panels, their cost (and installation) and the Government cash back scheme. Current tariffs are in place until April 2012, but after this date the amount of cash back will be reduced.

Trevor put forward the idea that TH could start a Solar Buying Group - the "Horsham 100". If there were enough people in the Horsham area interested in installing panels they could be purchased in bulk which would bring down the cost and probably the cost of installation could be discounted as well.

In further discussion it emerged that Germany is about 10-15 years ahead of us with their renewable energy programme - the price of their solar panels is much lower than in the UK so if we could purchase panels from Germany and have them transported to the UK that could be a viable option to reduce costs.
